Calrossy Anglican School has a rich tradition of distinctive and sophisticated uniforms and students wear their uniform with pride in themselves, their personal appearance and in membership of our School community.

In September 2021 Calrossy announced a new formal uniform for K - 12 students. There is a two-year transition period, so the current uniform can still be worn until the end of 2023.

The Calrossy uniform provides a unified "one school" look that links together all students', while recognising the structure of our School.

After more than 100 years of quality education, the smart contemporary uniform takes Calrossy into its second century of learning.

The move to a new uniform for Calrossy began several years prior, with the Parents and Friends Association and uniform suppliers, Noone Imagewear, tasked with investigating options.

Staff, parents and students provided feedback and initial storyboards were created. The School's archives were also carefully consulted. Calrossy's varied history meant there were several iconic and much-loved elements, such as the Secondary Girls' red blazers, the Secondary Boys' chambray shirts and the "tartan". Following surveys of the School community (that included students past and present, staff and parents), our new uniform has been launched.

The new uniform features a "One School" look based on red and navy and the changes reflect the transition of students through the School.

THE CALROSSY UNIFORM CODE & DRESS REQUIREMENTS



CALROSSY REPUTATION

Calrossy Anglican School has earned an enviable reputation in the Tamworth and North - West community over many years. Student presentation enhances an image reflecting high standards and pride.

Our uniform is distinctive and student appearance creates a favourable impression. Every School member benefits from our reputation and so care is required, with presentation and public behaviour to enhance and maintain this.

CALROSSY DOOR TO DOOR POLICY

Calrossy has a “door to door” Uniform policy and students must wear their school uniform to and from School in the appropriate manner. The School is committed to maintaining the agreement made with parents at enrolment, that the correct uniform will be worn and be worn correctly.

Parents can be of great assistance to their children and to staff by fully supporting the correct uniform requirements.

Students who fail to adhere to the Uniform Guide will receive disciplinary action.

THE CALROSSY UNIFORM SHOP

Calrossy’s official uniform provider is Noone Imagewear and our Uniform Shop is located on the Brisbane Street Campus.

The Uniform Shop is open three days a week during the school term (Monday, Wednesday and Friday). Holiday opening hours can be found on the website.

UNIFORM GUIDE



UNIFORM ITEM GUIDELINES

SHIRTS

Blouses and shirts are to be buttoned up correctly. Winter shirts must be tucked in and buttoned to the neck. Sports shirts do not need to be tucked in. NB: Bras should be white or skin toned, not coloured.

SKIRTS AND TROUSERS

must be worn on the waist not the hips.

TIES

Are to be worn correctly i.e. done up to the neck.

BLAZERS

BLAZERS are required TO AND FROM SCHOOL in Terms 2 and 3 BY ALL STUDENTS from Year 3 onward.

HATS

Formal dress hats must be worn TO AND FROM SCHOOL BY ALL STUDENTS from Year 3 and in public. An appropriate School hat must also be worn for outside activities.

SHOES

For general safety reasons, standard black lace up shoes are the only acceptable footwear.

Joggers can be worn with the sport uniform. Please see Page 18 for more information.

MAKEUP

No makeup of any sort is to be worn. Senior Girls (Yr 10 - Yr 12) are permitted to wear tinted moisturiser/sunscreen in their natural skin tone, which must be applied lightly. No other makeup is allowed (eg: Foundation or Mascara).

NAILS

Artificial nails (eg Acrylic, tips etc) and coloured nail polish are not permitted.

BODY ART

No student is permitted to have visible tattoos or body piercings (except simple stud or sleeper style earrings for girls). Henna tattoos are not to be worn.

HAIR

Girls' hair longer than shoulder length must be tied BACK (off the face) and UP off the shoulders.

- any short or loose strands of hair must be pinned or clipped BACK
- fringes must be trimmed well clear of eyebrows
- hair cannot be dyed or coloured unnatural or multiple colours

HAIR ACCESSORIES

- all hair accessories must be plain navy or white. with the exception of hair coloured bobby pins and small plain silver clips.
- NB: The School reserves the right to rule on the appropriateness of any hair style or variation.

JEWELLERY

Girls may wear a single pair of pierced earrings in the earlobe; they need to be a small sleeper, pearl, or simple stud style; no other piercings are acceptable. No other jewellery is acceptable except a watch.

The wearing of rings, bangles, bracelets and necklaces or other items of jewellery is not permitted. No visible body piercings are permitted including tongue studs – this includes clear studs or stoppers

SCHOOL BAGS

Students are required to use the Calrossy School approved bag which is also part of their School uniform. Unless otherwise discussed, bags are to be stored in the student's locker. Stickers and text markings are not to be used to decorate School bags. Key rings may be used to identify school bags.

BOYS

UNIFORM ITEM GUIDELINES

SHIRTS

Shirts are to be buttoned up correctly. Winter shirts must be tucked in and buttoned to the neck. Summer shirts must not be unbuttoned more than one button from the collar. Sport shirts do not need to be tucked in.

TROUSERS AND SHORTS

Must be worn on the waist, not the hips. Shorts are to be just above the knee.

TIES

Are to be worn correctly and done up to the neck.

BELTS (Yr 7 onwards)

Only black School issue belts purchased from the Noone Calrossy Uniform Shop are permitted. No other style or colour of belt is to be worn. **R M Williams belts are not permitted.**

SHOES

For general safety reasons, standard black lace up shoes are the only acceptable footwear. Joggers can be worn with the sport uniform. (See page 18)

BLAZERS

BLAZERS are required **TO AND FROM SCHOOL** in Terms 2 and 3 **BY ALL STUDENTS** from Year 3 onward.

HATS

The formal navy dress hats must be worn **TO AND FROM SCHOOL BY ALL STUDENTS** from Year 3 and also be worn in public. An appropriate School hat or cap must also be worn for outside activities.

SCHOOL BAGS

Students are required to use the Calrossy School approved bag which is also part of their School uniform.

Unless otherwise discussed, bags are to be stored in the student's locker. Stickers and markers are not to be used to decorate School bags. Key rings may be used for identification.

BODY ART

No student is permitted to have visible tattoos or body piercings. Henna tattoos are not to be worn.

HAIR

Hair should be neat and tidy.

Hair styles must be conventional (eg, no unkempt hair, shaved sections of hair/eyebrows, undercuts, mohawks, use of gel, uneven grades shorter than a number 2)

Boys hair must be above the collar and eyebrows and a style and length unlikely to cause comment such as mullets, sharkeys etc.

Tied back hair is not permitted. Face is to be clean shaven.

Sideburns should be no lower than the ear lobe. Hair should be a natural colour.

JEWELLERY

Boys are not permitted to wear earrings, have piercings including tongue studs, clear studs or stoppers or any form of jewellery apart from a watch.

CALROSSY PRESCHOOL



BRIGHT AND FUN OPTIONS

Our youngest students which are part of Calrossy's community based Preschool are encouraged to wear play based clothes. Calrossy Preschool has polo shirts and bucket hats in a range of bright fun colours for boys and girls available for purchase at the Calrossy Uniform Shop, however these items are not compulsory.

CALROSSY PREP

Prep students have a play-based uniform. This uniform is designed to be practical, affordable and most importantly comfortable. The Prep uniform is based on Calrossy's Sport/PDHPE Uniform and will be worn as the sport uniform once the children head to Kindergarten.

Summer: Polo shirt, shorts or skirt, sport socks and joggers.

Winter: Same as Summer with the addition of track pants and jersey.

A School bucket hat must be worn all year. A navy soft shell jacket is optional.

KINDERGARTEN TO YR 6

The Calrossy colours of Navy and Red have been adopted for the Junior School from 2022 replacing the bottle green providing a 'One School' look.

The new Calrossy navy and red stripe is featured on the girls summer dress, Winter tunic and on the boys Winter tie.

A new more serviceable blue chambray shirt is now featured replacing the previous white shirts for both summer and winter for our Junior School boys. We also have the addition of soft shell jackets that are available for Prep through to Year 2.

A red with navy trim girls blazer and navy with red trim boys blazer is to be worn from Year 3 through to Year 9 and is a compulsory part of the uniform. Navy pants have been added as an option for the girls in the cooler months for Terms 2 and 3.

The new Calrossy stripe is now featured in the Secondary School Calrossy 7 - 9 Campus for the girls in their Summer dress and Winter skirts. The navy/chambray combination continues from Calrossy Junior School for our boys in these years.

The rite of passage to Secondary is recognised with a new navy tie with the Calrossy crest for the boys and girls which is worn with the Winter uniform. The girls red and boys navy blazers remain an iconic item and continue to be worn as part of the uniform suite for Calrossy 7 - 9 students on the William Cowper Campus. Tailored pants have been added as an option for the girls in the cooler months for Terms 2 and 3.

RITE OF PASSAGE FOR OUR SENIOR STUDENTS

The Calrossy senior student uniforms feature a distinctive red and navy Calrossy stripe blazer which represents the ties to the history of the Calrossy Girls School and the William Cowper Secondary Boys School.

New historically embossed navy ties have also been introduced to mark the transition to the senior years. White short and long sleeved shirts with the Calrossy crest and navy piping for both the girls and boys are also part of the Senior uniform in Summer and Winter.

The senior girls uniform also consists of a trans-seasonal navy box pleat skirt and tailored pants have been added as an option for the girls in the cooler months for Terms 2 and 3.

CALROSSY SPORT/PDHPE

From Prep to Year 12 the Calrossy sports uniform remains constant, delivering affordability and brand recognition. The Calrossy sport uniform consists of a red/navy polo shirt and navy Calrossy crest shorts or skort.

Trackpants, jersey and soft-shell jackets can be worn in the cooler months. Junior School students have a bucket hat for sport, while Secondary students have the option of a bucket hat or a navy, red or white Calrossy crest cap.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHERE DO WE GO FOR FITTINGS AND TO PURCHASE THE CALROSSY UNIFORM?

All uniform items are available from Calrossy's Uniform Shop located on the Brisbane Street Campus. The shop is usually open three days a week during the school term;
Monday 8am - 4.30pm
Wednesday 11am - 4.30pm
Friday 8am - 4.30pm

ARE THERE PANTS/SHORTS/ SKORT OPTIONS FOR GIRLS?

Navy tailored pants have been added as an option for the girls in both the Junior and Secondary years. These can be worn in the cooler months of Terms 2 and 3. The School is negotiating summer options.

CAN MY CHILD KEEP WEARING THE OLD UNIFORM?

There is a two-year phase in period for the new uniform. During this transition period students are able to wear the old uniform. Students will not be able to wear a mix of uniforms, however, our current Year 10 students will have a three-year phase in period, as their final year consists of only three terms. All other students will be required to wear the new uniform from 2024.

WHAT CONSIDERATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR COMFORT?

Design changes have been made to ensure greater quality and fit where possible. The range takes into account different body shapes and allows for a more modern look and fit, with tailored pants, shorts, skirts and tunics.

Breathable fabric choices have been made that account for Tamworth's extreme weather. The Summer shirts and tunics are a polycotton blend, which is a lightweight, breathable and durable fabric. The pants and shorts are a polyester viscose blend that means they are comfortable to wear but easy to care for. They are machine washable and can be tumble dried. Noone Imagewear have confirmed that all items have anti-fade properties.

CAN THE OLD BLAZERS BE REPOCKETED?

Noone Imagewear will be supplying pockets for the Red Blazers to purchase. They are unable to supply Navy ones as the dye lots are different. Hat bands are also available.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HAS THERE BEEN CONSIDERATION OF AFFORDABILITY?

The transition to a new uniform will likely involve some extra cost for families, who were planning on using second-hand items into the future. The new items are not expected to cost more than the old uniform and it is hoped on average families in the long term will pay less for uniforms. This is due to; The same blazer will be worn from Year 3 to Year 9 for girls and boys.

The same shirts and trousers are worn from Kindy to Year 9 for Secondary Boys, meaning families will only be purchasing new uniforms when students grow out of them.

WHAT WILL BE DONE WITH THE PREVIOUS UNIFORM?

Calrossy, in conjunction with Noone Imagewear, will arrange to repurpose or donate all existing stock of the old uniform to charity providers.

WILL THE SPORT UNIFORM BE CHANGING?

There will be no change to the sport uniform, which has already been updated in recent years. There will be additional team sport uniform items that will be transitioned into Calrossy Team Kits over the next few years. These items will be used for sports such as Basketball, HRIS representation, Rugby, Cricket and Football.

WHAT ARE THE RULES FOR THE WEARING OF HATS?

Formal navy dress hats must be worn TO AND FROM SCHOOL in Terms 2 and 3 BY ALL STUDENTS from Year 3 and also be worn in public. An appropriate School hat or cap must also be worn for outside activities. Caps are allowed to be worn once students arrive on Campus.

THE CARE INSTRUCTIONS ON SOME NEW UNIFORM ITEMS SAY "DRY CLEAN ONLY". ARE THESE ITEMS ABLE TO BE MACHINE WASHED?

Noone Imagewear have assured the School it is acceptable to machine wash these items on a gentle cycle. They advise to avoid tumble drying.



SHOE GUIDE

For general safety reasons, standard black lace up shoes are the only acceptable footwear. Predominantly white lace up joggers are the only acceptable sport footwear. Velcro shoes are permitted for Kindergarten to Year 2 only.
