

Our Classrooms

Calrossy is a unique educational environment offering your son and daughter the benefits of a personalised learning setting yet the benefits and resources of a much larger school community. In seeking to promote educational excellence the school has developed a commitment to personal attention for students; an emphasis on literacy, numeracy and research skills; support teaching, integration and extension programs; technology integration and a diverse range of co-curricular activities.

Calrossy students are encouraged to aim for achievement and enjoyment in all aspects of School life and given every opportunity in their chosen academic and co-curricular pursuits. We strive for excellence in all aspects of teaching and learning, aiming to ensure that each child is continuously challenged to seek new horizons and areas of growth. The acquisition of numeracy and literacy skills provides the foundation for the development of higher order skills in reasoning, research and problem solving in all areas of the curriculum. Students requiring more learning support or extension are quickly identified and appropriate strategies and assistance is put into place. All classes have specialist teachers in Music, Japanese and Christian Studies.

Calrossy places emphasis on developing students who are 21st Century learners. Our School has become a leader in the learning of Information Communication Technologies, with a designated Makerspaces including the latest coding equipment, green screen technology and a 3D printer, ensuring our students have the latest digital and technology skills needed for the future workforce.

Beyond the Classroom

At Calrossy Anglican School the Co-curricular program has a strong and rich tradition and is seen as a valuable part of your child's all-round education. These activities are seen as a vital part of the School's Wellbeing program and are important for establishing links outside of the classroom and the social and physical development of each student.

The extensive opportunities beyond the classroom complements the academic curriculum and provides additional opportunities for growth and learning. These opportunities include equestrian, music and creative and performing arts, sporting activities and agriculture. An instrumental program is offered to students from Year 3 and beyond, where they are encouraged to join the School band and choirs.

Calrossy offers the opportunity to participate in a wide range of sports, both individually and as a team. We aim to encourage participation and interest in sport and foster an environment of sportsmanship and encouragement. Students have pathways to compete at a regional, State and National level through school sporting representation.

The Primary School excursion program strives to provide experiences that develop and nourish each boy and girl. These excursions complement the learning programs and curriculum being taught, giving our students real life practical experiences to enhance their understanding of subjects and life, while contributing to their social and emotional growth and Wellbeing. All our students take part in local trips with our students undertaking major excursions from Year 3 onwards, culminating in a five-day expedition to Canberra.


Wellbeing

Calrossy has a proven and established Wellbeing program in the Primary area, implemented both within and outside of the classroom. This begins with a “buddy system” for our youngest students and continues throughout the year with other mentoring and peer support programs based on the School’s values, such as regular “bounce back days” that focus on anti-bullying and inclusion.

Calrossy strives to create a positive, respectful, secure and Christian environment. While Calrossy is a Christian school we welcome and celebrate students and families of any faith and background. Each week our Primary students focus on a particular value, such as trustworthiness or respect. Students are encouraged to put these values into practice everyday at school and at home.

Weekly assemblies are held for Infant and Primary students. These are hosted by a class and celebrate the students’ achievements while helping them grow in confidence and pride.
