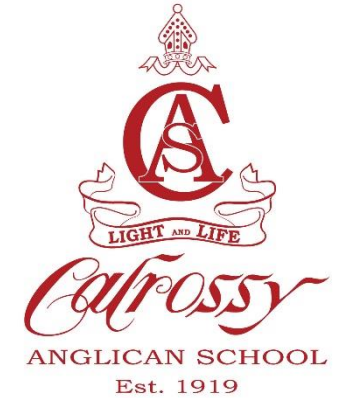


Qkr! and how to use it Online Version



Qkr! (pronounced "quicker") is a mobile payment app developed by Mastercard for Australian schools. Its purpose is to deliver convenience to parents, minimise cash handling and provide comprehensive reporting to administration staff.



If you are familiar with PayPal, it works in a similar fashion.

You register your information and link a credit or debit card to the app which enables you to make purchases. Any costs are deducted from your nominated card.

You can also use the app for "purchases" that do not require payment, such as permission notes for excursions or sporting events.

Introducing Qkr! (pronounced "quicker") by MasterCard, the secure and easy way to order and pay for school items from your phone at a time and place that suits you.

With Qkr you can:

- Pay for school fees, uniforms, excursions and more;
- See your receipts on the app and get them sent by email if required.

Getting started is easy - try it yourself today

Step 1 Download Qkr!
on your Android phone or iPhone. iPad users can download iPhone app

Step 2 Register
Select your Country of Residence as 'Australia' and follow the steps to register

Step 3 Find our school
Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10km's of the school, or search for our school by name.

Step 4 Register your children
When first accessing our school you will be prompted to add a student profile for your child. This allows you to make orders and payments for them.

If you have made a purchase you can select our school from 'Previous Location'

If you're within 10 kms of the school, you can select our school from 'Nearby Locations'

Add your children's details in Student Profiles

Select 'Add student profile'

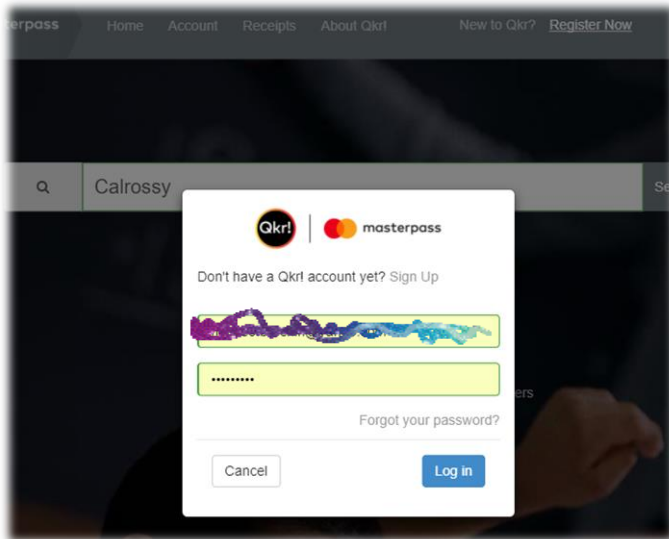
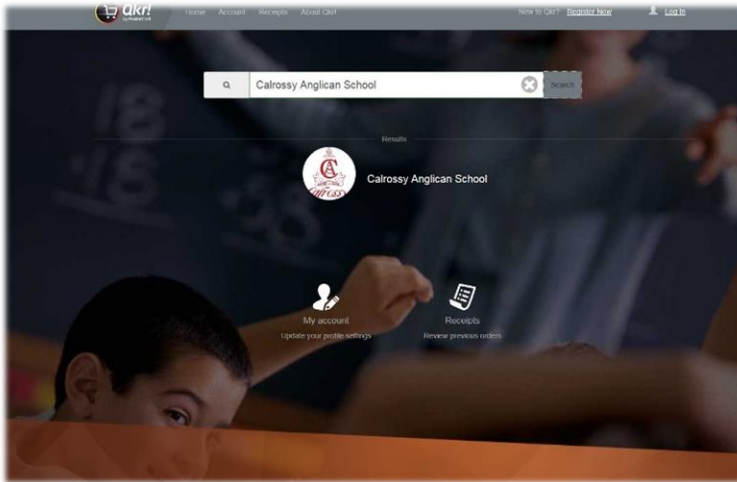
Add up to 5 cards to your wallet

Pay with any cards accepted by the school.

Once your payment is approved you can continue to the home page, or view your receipt.

Once you have registered, the web version takes you to this login screen. Once you have chosen Calrossy, you can start your orders. As an example, let's choose a sport payment.
